

PAL-SPONSORED SHOWS & EXHIBITS

PAL sponsors a number of art shows every year including our Members' Shows (organized by our Board of Directors Vice Presidents), Specialty Shows (organized by individual members) and our annual Open Show (organized by an official committee).

MEMBERS' SHOWS

There are usually three **Members' Shows** each year. To participate in our Members' Shows you must be:

- a current (dues paid) PAL member
- screened in the medium you are entering in the show

Entry is limited to one piece (based on the specific size requirements for the show).

If the piece has been shown in a Specialty Show, it is still acceptable for a Members' Show.

Entry fee is \$15.

PAL sponsors (pays for) the reception, the awards and the Juror.

The Second Vice-Presidents are in charge of Members' Shows.

SPECIALTY SHOWS & EVENTS

Specialty Shows are unique events organized by individual PAL members, usually around a specific theme. To enter a Specialty Show, you must be:

- a current (dues paid) PAL member
- screened in the medium you are entering in the show

Paintings entered in Specialty Shows can also be entered in a PAL Members' Show.

Each Specialty Show specifies the entry fee and the number and size of entries acceptable.

Specialty Shows must be approved by the PAL Board of Directors. The organizer of the proposed show must present a proposal to the board, including the following information:

Name of event

Name of organizer

Name of juror(s) (if applicable)

Show dates

Venue of the show

Synopsis of what the show will look like

Cost of venue, juror, promotional materials, etc.

If you want to organize a Specialty Show, complete the Specialty Event Proposal (found on page two) and submit it to the PAL Board of Directors for consideration. The Board may or may not agree to sponsor (fund) the show.

Board meetings are held at 10am on the Thursday prior to the general meeting. Check the Calendar page on the PAL website for Board meeting location.

OPEN SHOW

This show draws entries from across the U.S. and Canada and does not require PAL membership. You can enter the same piece(s) that have been in a Members' Show or Specialty Show. The Open Show is organized by the Open Show Committee and the awards, juror and reception are paid for by PAL.

(Sponsors and Friends of PAL can also present awards as approved by the Open Show Committee.)
